2. Is the AEI course accredited?

3. What type of registration, participation and continuing education credit documentation will I receive?

Let's take those one at a time:

1. Registration Verification: you will receive a registration confirmation via email immediately after you register by phone.
2. Participation Certificate: You will receive a Certificate of Participation on your last day of attendance of an AEI course. The certificate of participation will indicate that you participated in the course in the location from which you attended, and the week that you attended.
3. Continuing Education Credit: while the exact format of your credit award documentation will vary from profession to profession with AEI's online credit request process at the end of your participation in a course you can request credits for those lectures you attended and receive your certificate *immediately* via email.

4. How will the course be presented?

A physical classroom will be setup in the resort with scheduled classes projected on a large screen. Alternatively, participants will have the option of logging in on their personal devices (laptop or tablet) and enjoy the lectures virtually. ***Attendees will have to log in via their personal device to record their attendance.***

5. How do I register for the CME course?
